



VACCINATION DECLARATION 2017-2018

Vaccination program

Calves must be vaccinated against the following:

- Infectious Bovine Rhinotracheitis (IBR)
 Parainfluenza 3 (PI₃)
 Bovine Respiratory Syncytial Virus (BRSV)
 Bovine Viral Diarrhea (BVD)

Calves marketed must be vaccinated according to one of the 2 following vaccination programs:

Killed vaccine (2 doses):

Vaccine administered to a calf at least 4 months of age. The booster dose must always be given 2 to 4 weeks after the first dose. At the very latest, the vaccine (1st dose) must be administered 4 weeks before the sale and the booster 2 weeks before the sale.

Modified live vaccine (1 dose):

Administered to a calf at least 4 months of age at least 2 weeks prior to the sale.

Reminder: the maximum time allowed between the sale date and the vaccination date is 4 months.

The veterinarian's recommendations must be followed at all times.

² Ionophores: Rumensin, Bovatec, Posistac ³ Chlor-100, Auréo S-700, etc.

⁴ Any injectable or oral antibiotic in absence of fever.
