40TH ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING OF PRODUCERS GOVERNED BY THE PLAN CONJOINT DES PRODUCTEURS DE BOVINS DU QUÉBEC

To all cattle producers,

You are invited to the Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the Quebec cattle producers. It will be held on March 29th-30th, 2022, at the **Hotel Le Concorde in Quebec**, located at 1225 Cours du General-de Montcalm, Quebec. The AGM is an event not to be missed for Quebec cattle producers. However, please note that only the producers delegated by their regional union have the right to vote.

The Agenda, which you will find on the reverse side, lists the topics that will be discussed. Delegates of the *Plan conjoint des Producteurs de bovins du Québec* (Joint Plan) will be asked to vote on the 2023-2025 Joint Plan's Financing Plan and so, on changes to the *Règlement sur les contributions des producteurs de bovins*, among other things. Also, amendments to the *Règlement sur le Fonds des producteurs de bovins pour la recherche et le développement* will be proposed to the feeder calf and cull cattle producers during the workshops as well as to the AGM delegates in order to modify articles 8 and 12.

We also invite you to consult the Rules of Procedure beforehand since they are not going to be read during the AGM this year. To do so, go to https://cutt.ly/en-aga-pbq-2022. All AGM documents will be available there as well.

By participating at your AGM, you contribute to the discussions that result in the adoption of your organization's key directions and policies. I invite you to take advantage of this annual gathering to socialize with your peers and to speak with representatives of the cattle industry. The workshops, cocktail and banquet are an excellent opportunity for this.
