Overview



The grain-fed veal sector is a group within Les Producteurs de bovins du Québec (PBQ). It plays a central role in defending producers' interests. Under the *Plan conjoint des producteurs de bovins du Québec* (Quebec cattle producers' joint plan), the sector created a sales agency that ensures its products are marketed in an effective and orderly way. This gives all producers and buyers access to the grain-fed veal market under the same conditions.

The sector has also implemented production volume control mechanisms to ensure the market has a regular supply.

There is also a marketing committee made up of producers from all regions of Quebec where grain-fed veal is produced. It monitors the functioning of the sales agency and adopts the strategic directions set by the sector.

Services open to all producers

Marketing: The sector negotiates and enforces the marketing agreement with buyers. This agreement sets out fair conditions for all producers and guarantees that calves are always sold. It also inspects slaughterhouses to ensure the rules are being followed (e.g., carcass trimming, weighing, grading).

Research and development: The creation of a research fund has provided money for various projects that benefit the whole sector. In recent years, efforts have been concentrated on carcass quality and calf diets.



Training: You have access to <u>webinars and</u> <u>factsheets</u> on topics ranging from onfarm biosecurity to managing employees to water quality. The sector also helps organize the *Journée INPACQ veaux de grain*, a forum that fosters knowledge transfer and the sharing of best practices. These training opportunities for producers are also part of the continuous training for Verified Veal and Quebec Grain-Fed Veal certification.



Promotion: <u>Quebec Veal</u> is the only meat of its kind in the world, and the sector works hard to get the word out to consumers! The promotional fund enhances the visibility of veal during the most strategic periods of the year, which helps move more products.

Payment guarantee: What if a buyer fails to pay? This self-insurance program guarantees that producers in the grainfed veal sector receive payment for all animals they sell in accordance with the regulation.

Media: From the weekly newsletter (*VG Hebdo*) to the technical feature (*Bovins du Québec*) to the website, the media developed by the PBQ are your go-to place for production-related info, training opportunities, and industry-related events.
